




18. Budget Workshop on the Preparation of the FY 2023 Trinity County Budget – Hear Budget Requests from Each Department

19. With no further business to come before the Commissioner's Court, court adjourned with a motion from Commissioner Truss and seconded by Commissioner Smith. Motion carried.






Tommy Park, Commissioner, Pct. 1
